 - Families will need to provide their child(ren)'s name(s) and will be asked to take the meals home with them.
 - There will be no eating at the school or use of the school by students and families during this time.

- Meal distribution will be at the front entrance (Door 1) of Trumbull High School. Please look for TPS food services staff and security personnel, who will direct traffic for the curbside pickup.
- Beginning Tuesday, March 17, this service will be offered Monday through Friday for the duration of the closure of the Trumbull Public Schools.

- Norwalk Public Schools and Chartwells will provide free daily breakfast and lunch to all students age 18 and under. To help limit exposure and promote social distancing, meals will be delivered to a majority of students via school bus at bus stops. Starting Monday, a bus driver and a food service worker will stop at each regularly scheduled bus stop to deliver meals to students. The food service worker will exit the bus and hand a bag containing breakfast and lunch to each student at the stop. Buses will operate on a two-hour delayed schedule. Those who are interested in receiving meals should be at their bus stop two hours after their normally scheduled morning pick-up time.

Providing Meals for Free and Reduced Lunch Students

- **Bronx (March 16-20)**

- Free grab-and-go breakfast and lunch meals will be available at the entrance of every NYC school from 7:30 AM - 1:30 PM
